D.A.V. NANDRAJ PUBLIC SCHOOL was founded in the year 1981 at Burdwan Compound, Lalpur, Ranchi by Arya Samaj led by the true Karmayogi, Late Narayan Das Grover, who was a committed worker of Arya Samaj. He rendered his selfless services and bestowed the benefits of his experience upon this institution and nurtured it. The foundation stone was laid by Dr. Dukhan Ram, ex President of Arya Pradeshik Sabha and an eminent eye specialist of his time. Late Master Tek Chand Arya, Shri Madan Gopal Sethi, Shri Shatrughan Lal Gupta, Shri Prem Prakash Arya and Shri Ashok Bhatia were the esteemed members of the local managing committee. Later, the School management was separated and the same members founded a society named Arya Gyan Prachar Samiti, Ranchi. Since then, their relentless efforts have constantly guided us to achieve the goals of excellence in education. Our school has been smoothly progressing on the path shown by Swami Dayanand Saraswati, the great pathmaker of modern India who raised his stentorian voice against foreign

rule in a publication called Satyarth Prakash. He set before us the ideal of Swaraj and advocated the eradication of untouchability, the emancipation of women, and widow remarriage. He opined that a human being enters into a class of society according to her or his Guna (talent), Karma (work), and Sadhbava (nature). Assembly and Moral Education

The school starts with the morning assembly with the recitation of Vedic Mantras, devotional songs, patriotic songs, and thought for the day. Stress is laid upon the universal aspects and eternal values of Indian Culture. Short talks are given by the students and the teachers on a variety of subjects and important current affairs. The news is read by the students daily. Every morning the assembly is dispersed after the singing of the National Anthem.

Hawan Yajna is performed every Tuesday and Thursday. Dharma Shiksha books are made available in the library for all to read. Vedic Initiation Camp is held once a year.

Computer

In the modern age of technology, computers have become a basic need. Knowledge about working with a computer has become important in all walks of life. The students here get ample opportunities to sharpen their skills. The computer lab here consists of 30 Pentium IV computers.

Learning Through Interaction

The school becomes a platform for free and fruitful interaction amongst the teachers and students to create a healthy learning environment, and to provide a good quality of education which leaves lasting impressions on young minds.

Laboratories

A laboratory is a vital need for practical education. It enhances the grasping capacity of the students. The school has three spacious and modern science laboratories. They are all equipped with the latest laboratory gadgets and testing equipments. Experienced teachers are always ready to guide the students.

Emphasis on Pre-Primary Education

Keeping in mind the most formative part of a child's life, our pre-primary section functions as a catalyst to accelerate optimum development of a child. Development of young children is a process which is influenced by their experiences, which have a bearing on their attitudes towards most of the situations they are likely to face later in life. The children are encouraged through storytelling, recitation, and rhymes to be imaginative and creative.

Library

The school has a well-stocked library containing over 4500 volumes of books, journals, encyclopedias, almanacs, and magazines, which facilitate learning. A constant endeavour is made to enrich the library with the latest books.



Sports & Co-Curricular Activities

Games and Sports: The school aims for all-round development of the students. The children get excellent opportunities to develop their interests and abilities in games and sports under the guidance of trained instructors.

Art & Craft: Arts and crafts have the ability to boost creativity. The school has a separate art and craft section where the varied creative interests of students are taken care of under the guidance and supervision of professionally trained teachers. Art works and paintings are exhibited from time to time to give recognition to the talent of students.

Yoga and Meditation: Yoga is essential for physical, mental, and spiritual health and well-being. It is a part of the school curriculum. In the middle of busy schooldays, yoga and meditation classes provide a relaxing break.

Music & Dance: Apart from studies, the school provides music & dance training to the students. It is a mode of recreation that takes their minds off their hectic academic schedules for a while and rejuvenates their senses.

Drawing & Painting: The students get excellent training in sketching, drawing, and painting under the constant guidance of an able teacher.

Co-Curricular Activities: The students are exposed to co-curricular activities like dancing, public speaking, one-act plays, and celebration of all festivals and special days. Consistent monitoring of every student enables the teachers to recognize the field in which a particular child can excel. Children with similar interests and inclinations are grouped together and the teachers help them to nurture and cultivate their talents. Various inter-house activities and contests are held throughout the academic year.



Registration & Admission

- The Prospectus & Registration Form for admission to the school can be obtained from the school office.
- It should be duly filled and submitted with the required documents and certificates as mentioned in the form.
- Registration fee is non-refundable and registration is no guarantee for admission.
- Special consideration is given to Transfer cases and BPL Students.
- Birth Certificate issued by competent authorities and Transfer Certificate obtained from the previous school are essential at the time of admission.
- Fees must be deposited by the given dates, failing which the particular candidate may not be considered for admission.

Age Criteria

The basic age criteria for admission to classes Nursery & Prep. (Informal Education) and class 1 (Formal Education) is to be met according to the birth certificates issued by the Municipal Corporation or any other competent authority as given herewith.

School Uniform

A uniform fosters a sense of unity and community amongst students. All students are required to wear their designated uniforms everyday to school, unless otherwise instructed.





Identity card

An identity card bearing a passport size photograph and the address of the student must remain in their possession at all times.

Attendance

- 75% attendance is essential for promotion to the next higher class.
- No leave is granted except on prior application from parents/guardians for genuine reasons.
- In case of sickness, a medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner has to be submitted.
- Repeated absence without leave or unexplained leave for fifteen consecutive days renders a student liable to have their name struck off the rolls. They will be readmitted after paying readmission charges.
- It is compulsory for students to attend school on the first and last day after Summer Vacation, Puja Vacation, and Winter Vacation.
- Leave application has to be submitted to the class teacher for prior information or else the student will be fined.

Parents Corner

Do's :

- Use the school diary as a means of communication with the class teacher and check the diary for home work and teachers' remarks, if any.
- See the Test Papers as and when sent home.
- Send the children regularly and punctually to school. No absence will be permitted without a leave application and late comers will not be allowed to sit in class.
- Both the parents must attend the Parents-Teachers Meet.

Don'ts :

- Do not walk into the classrooms or meet a teacher while they are in a classroom. Please meet the teachers only with prior appointment through the Principal.
- Do not visit the teachers at their residence.
- Do not send money or valuable articles with the students. The school takes no responsibility in case those are lost.
- Do not give firecrackers for bursting in the school premises or buses.



Guideline for Students

- All the students must possess a school almanac, text books, note books, etc.
- Books, magazines, and articles (other than those required for everyday studies) brought to the school are liable to be confiscated.
- Students are advised not to bring valuable articles to school. The school will not be responsible for any lost goods.
- School bus users must strictly observe the rules of school transport. They must follow the instructions of the driver and the conductor.
- Application for leave must be submitted a day in advance. It should be counter-signed by the parents/guardians.
- The students must come to school in their school uniforms.
- They must stay neat, clean, and tidy.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school during working hours unless the parents/guardians whose signatures are on the forms and school almanac come in person to collect them.
- Students should maintain regularity in attendance.
- Any damage to the school property by the students will have to be borne by the student's parents/guardians.
- The school reserves the right to take stern action against those students who are found guilty of misconduct, and their names may even be struck off the school rolls.



Guideline for Parents

- Withdrawal from any class must be preceded by a month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
- All dues must be cleared before a Transfer Certificate is issued.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued one week after the receipt of the application.
- The parents may be asked by the school authorities to withdraw their child from the school, without prior notice, based on any of the following grounds:
 - a) Academic: Constant neglect of studies, such as those students who fail in the same class for two consecutive sessions.
 - b) Disciplinary: Conduct of the students being found harmful to the interests of the school in the opinion of the Principal.



Transport

The School provides transport facilities as per the convenience of the children. The transport routes have been specified and buses ply accordingly.
